

Regulation amending Regulation No 361/2016 on the Control of Services and Items that may have Strategic Significance, with subsequent amendments.

Article 1

Introduction of Acts.

Point 1.2. of Paragraph 1 of Article 2 of the Regulation is repealed.

Paragraph 2 of Article 2 of the Regulation is replaced by the following:

The following acts of the European Union on defence-related products shall apply in Iceland with the adaptations referred to in Article 7.:

Council Common Position 2008/944/CFSP of 8 December 2008 defining common rules governing control of exports of military technology and equipment, cf. accompanying document No 4 to Regulation No 758/2014 on the Control of Services and Items that may have Strategic Significance.

Commission Directive (EU) 2016/970 of 27 May 2016 amending Directive 2009/43/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of defence-related products, cf. accompanying document No 3.

The first sentence of Paragraph 1 of Article 4 of the Regulation shall be worded as follows:

The following acts of the European Union on export control shall enter into force in Iceland with the adaptations referred to in Article 7:

Point 1.3 of Paragraph 1 of Article 4 of the Regulation is replaced by the following:

Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2016/1969 of 12 September 2016 amending Council Regulation (EC) No 428/2009 setting up a Community regime for the control of exports, transfer, brokering and transit of dual-use items, cf. accompanying document No 4.

Article 2

Entry into force

This Regulation, which is adopted pursuant to Articles 4, 5 and 14 of Act No 58/2010 on the Control of Services and Items that may have Strategic Significance, shall enter into force immediately.
